Flashover Chamber

This is a one-day class designed to demonstrate to firefighters the phenomenon of “flashover”. This dangerous and deadly condition can be predicted with the correct training.

The class begins with a classroom session which explains flashover signs and signals. This session lasts approximately two hours. All of our lead instructors are certified as flashover instructors.

Following the classroom session, students will enter the flashover chamber where they will be exposed to several actual flashovers in a controlled environment. Students will learn how to anticipate flashover by carefully observing conditions.

This is a hands-on class in which the students will be subjected to high heat conditions and hostile fire conditions. Each student will need to complete a release form which requires the signature of their fire chief.



Each student must bring their own self contained breathing apparatus and turnout gear to include the following:

- SCBA
- Bunker pants
- Bunker coat
- Protective hood
- Approved gloves
- Boots

It is suggested that students wear several layers of clothing under their turnout gear. ESEC provides helmets with aluminized covering
